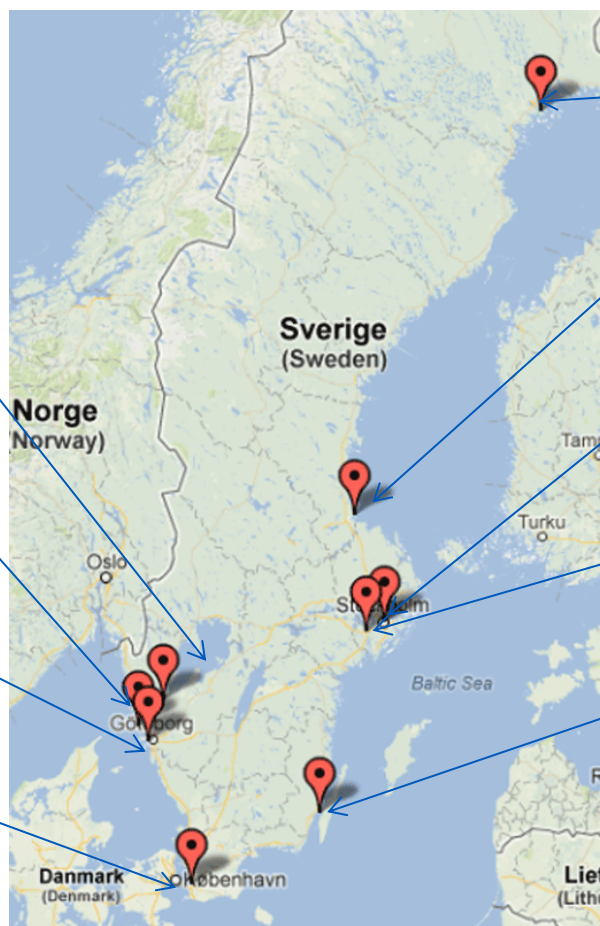

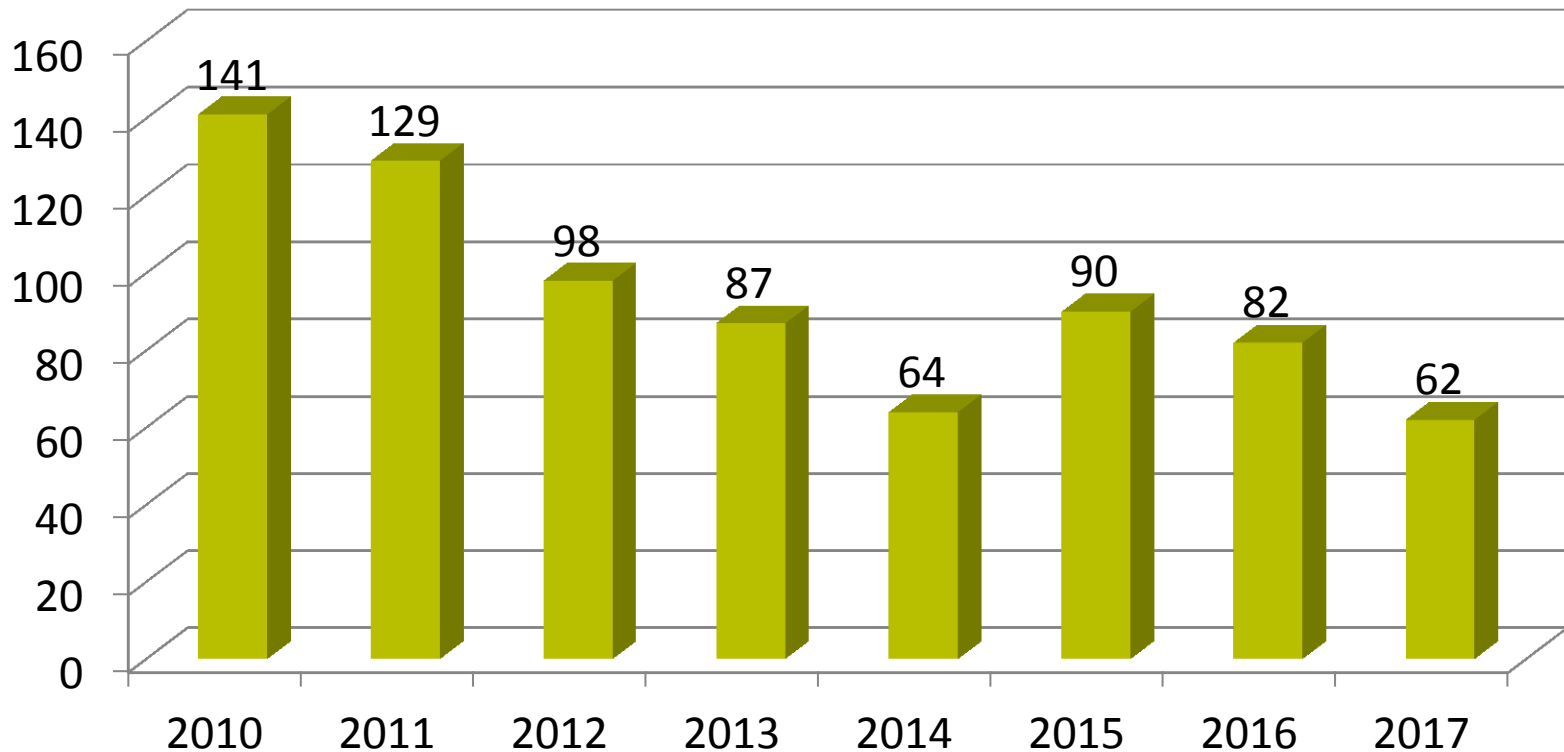

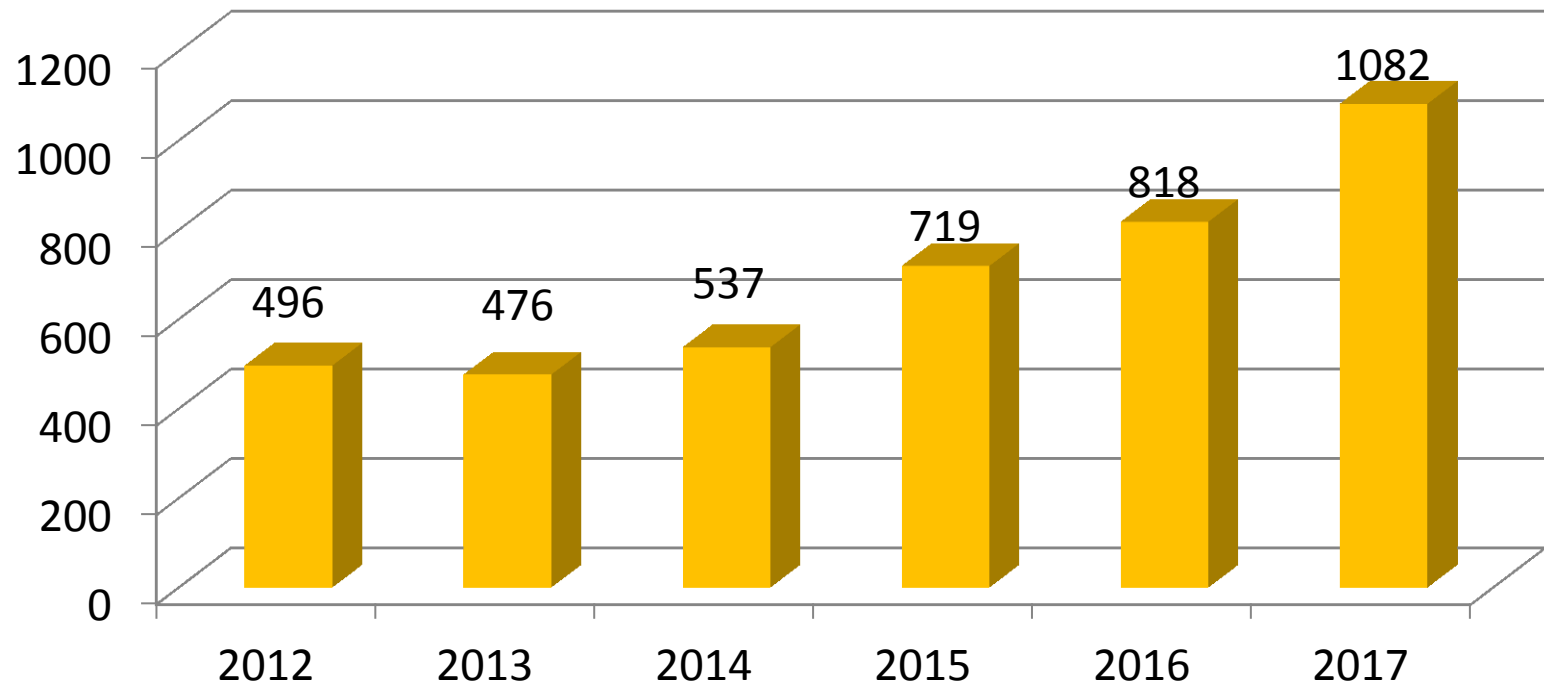
# Deep-sea pilotage missions in Sweden

2010-2017



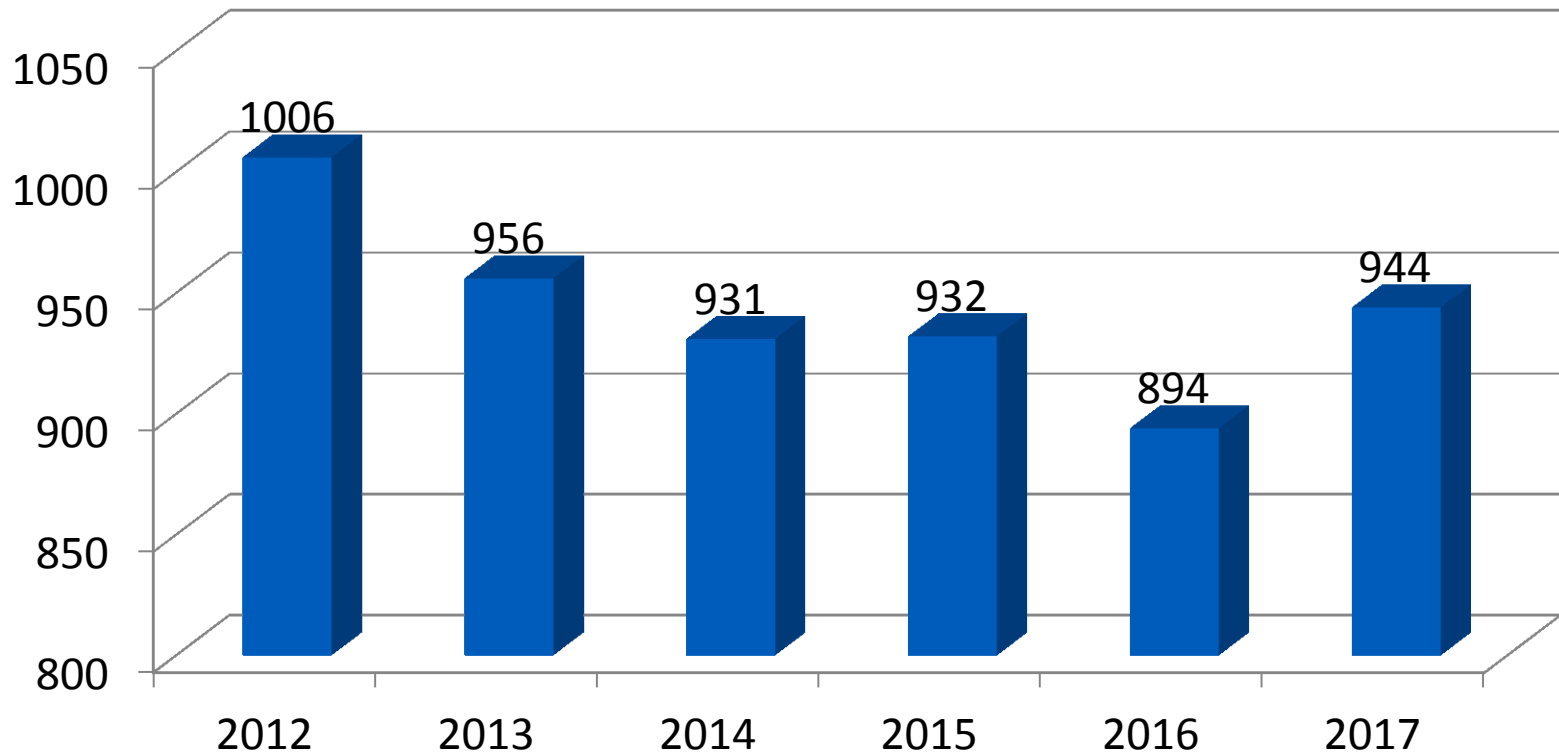
# Pilotage in the Sound

2012-2017



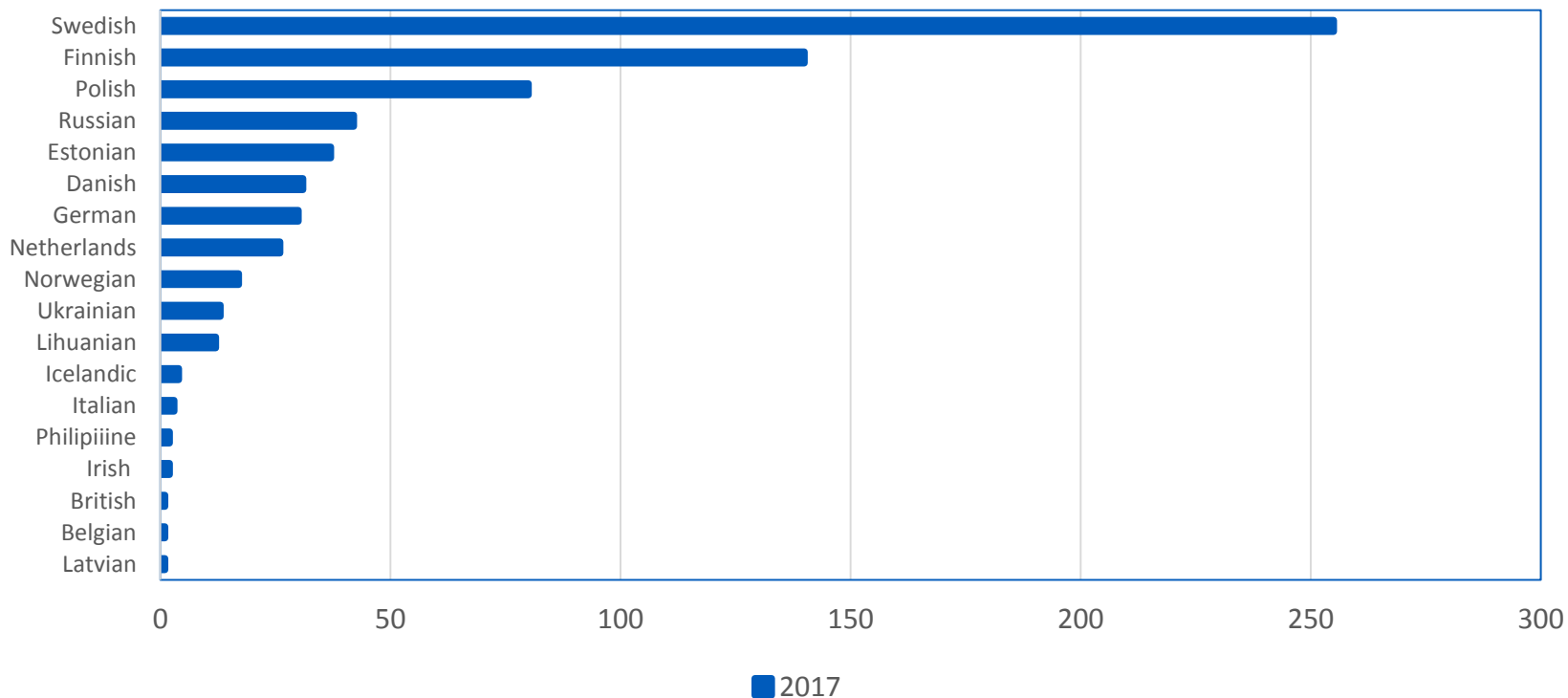

Valid PECs 2012-2017



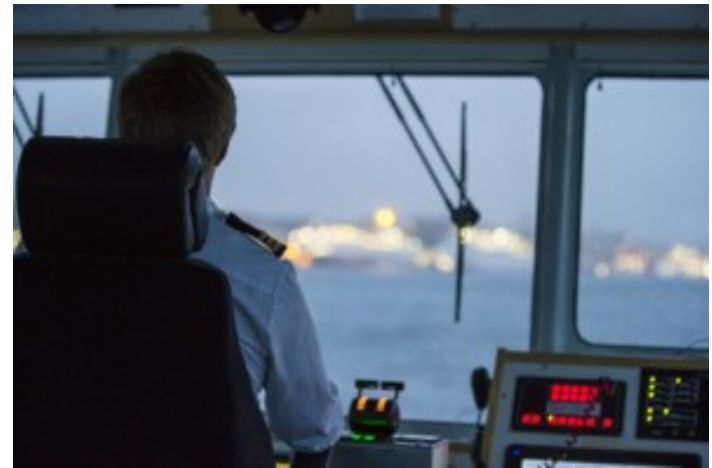

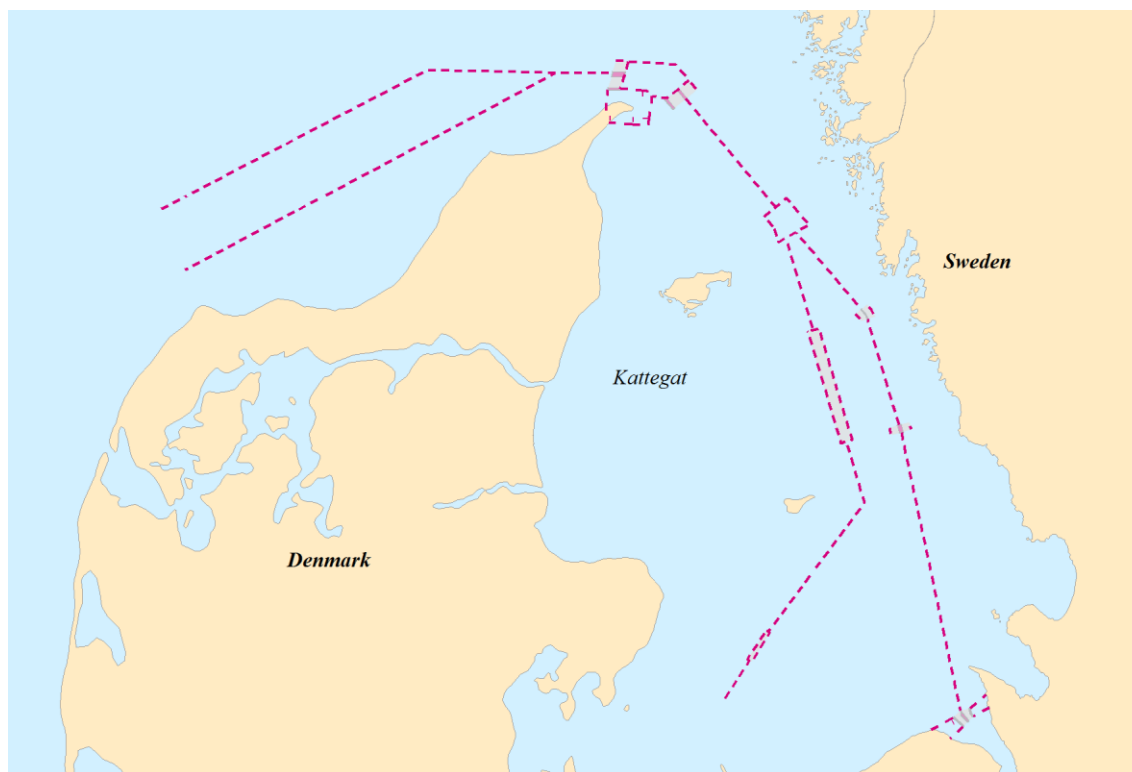
